| 95249 | Personal CGM placement, start-up, training, and technical components | RN, PharmD/RPh, RD, CDCES, MA | Once for the lifetime of the CGM device | Face-to-face |
| 95250 | Professional CGM physician or health professional (office) equipment, patient training, and technical components | RN, PharmD/RPH, RD, CDCES, MA | Once per month maximum | Face-to-face |
| 95251 | CGM Interpretation | Physician, NP, PA, or clinical nurse specialist | Once per month maximum | Face-to-face not required |
| -25 modifier | Evaluation and Management (Separate Identifiable Service) Can be billed same day as 95249, 95250, and/or 95251 if documentation supports medical necessity | Physician, NP, PA, or clinical nurse specialist | With office visits | Face-to-face |
